



Cat Boarding Vaccination & Health Requirements

To provide a safe and comfortable environment for all our feline guests, we require the following vaccinations and health protocols

Required Vaccinations

1. Rabies

- Legally mandated in Florida.
- Must be current within the last 1 to 3 years, depending on the vaccine used.

2. FVRCP (Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia)

- Protects against common and potentially severe feline diseases.
- Must be current within the last 1 to 3 years.

3. Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV)

- Required for cats that go outdoors or have had outdoor exposure.
 - Must be current within the last year.

Health Requirements

- **Fecal Examination:** A negative fecal exam within the past 12 months is required to ensure the cat is free from intestinal parasites.
 - **Parasite Prevention:** Cats should be on a regular flea and tick prevention regimen.
 - **Vaccination Timing:** All vaccinations should be administered **at least 7–10 days prior** to boarding to ensure full efficacy.

Documentation

Please provide the following:

- Written proof of all required vaccinations from your vet (*veterinary practice name and contact information must be visible*)



- Documentation of a recent negative fecal exam.
 - Details of current flea and tick prevention treatments.

Additional Recommendations

- **FeLV/FIV Testing:** While not mandatory, we recommend testing for Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) to ensure the health of all boarding cats.
 - **Personal Items:** You may bring your cat's favorite toys or bedding to make their stay more comfortable. Please ensure all items are clean and labeled.
